

The programme was started with lightening the lamp and NSS song. 49 students with NSS Program Officer Mr. Arun Aravind. NSS volunteers were divided into 7 groups. Documentation, Cultural, Manual and Cooking team. Manual work was done at Madappalli Village which lasted for four days covering the entire village. 


